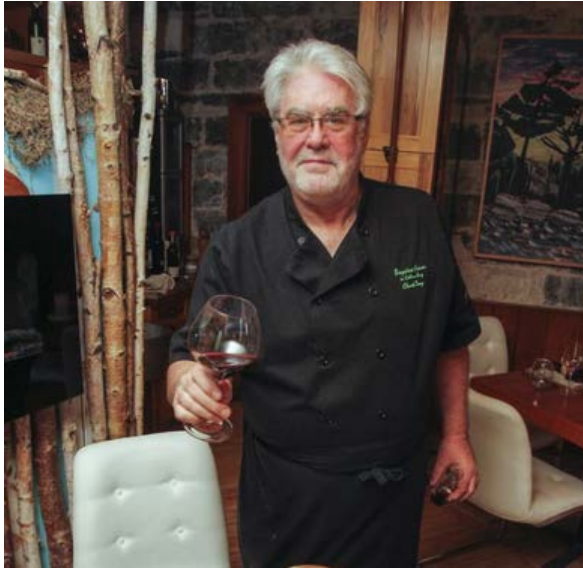

We are thrilled to have Clark Day as our special guest chef for our Cooking Class and Fundraising Event. Clark has a long history here in Kingston. He opened the River Mill - (yes, in the building Leahurst is in) on Cataraqui Street in 1984. Years later, he and his wife sold the restaurant and opened a new one, Clark's by the Bay, at his home in Collins Bay. Day, who advocated for eating locally grown food and drinking locally produced wine before it was fashionable, would later open Clark's on King after working with a winery and at restaurants in the Hub. He then joined AquaTerra restaurant as a consultant. He opened Bayview Farm in 2015 and retired in 2019.

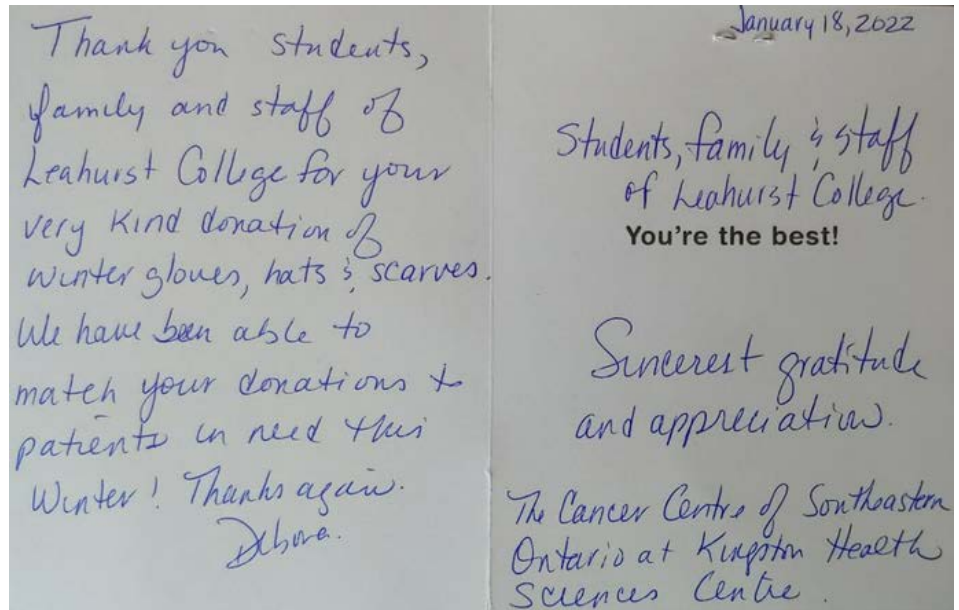
Grade 7 Problem Solving
