





### *Congratulations Ani!*

Science Fair Project: Approximately 42% of Gen Z has been diagnosed with a mental illness. Many are scared to share their struggles because they fear rejection (stigma). Ani tested how disclosure from both first and third parties would impact the associated stigma. Over 470 participants read a story describing someone's behavior. The story would either end, have the person shared their diagnosis, or have another person do so. Participants then would answer a series of questions measuring accountability and interest. She found that the individual disclosing their diagnosis significantly reduced the stigma (judgement, prejudice, rejection, etc.) felt towards those with a mental illness compared to when the diagnosis was shared by a third party or not at all. These results could lead to people being more willing to get the support they need and bring people closer together. It could also lead to less fear and less self hatred due to their condition.

### Hand Written Typography Art | Grade 7 Art

In Ms. Brown's Art Class, students created unique typography portraits of historical or modern-day inspirational figures. Using only descriptive words in their own handwriting, they formed images of their chosen figure's face, making the likeness visible through words that capture the individual's character, accomplishments, and values.





